Notes for Information:

1. These statistics refer to the applications for admission in 2010/2011 reported as of 29th April 2014.

The application cycle for each term ends on the Division of Term which is 9th November 2010, 13th February 2011, 21st May 2011 for Michaelmas Term 2010, Lent Term 2011 and Easter Term 2011 respectively.

- 2. Confirmation figures are those applicants who received confirmation of their place after satisfying all their conditions set out in the offer stage, and who then subsequently took up their places on the course. Applicants who were confirmed but subsequently did not take up their University place are excluded.¹
- 3. Home/EU/Overseas fee status is defined only at the point of offer, as this classification is dependent on a variety of factors that require independent assessment based on the UKCISA guidelines. For the purpose of estimating numbers of applicants within fee status categories who did not receive an offer, the fee status has been assessed based on primary citizenship only. Applicants with islands or refugee fee status have been included for this broad reporting purpose as Overseas.

Summary

The data has been prepared by Graduate Admissions Office for the Board of Graduate Studies (BGS) and Post-Graduate Admissions Committee (PAC) and are intended to provide a statistical analysis of applicants based on CAMSIS data.

Table 1.1 Applications and Confirmations by School and Fee Status

- The total number of applications is $13,725 (12,943)^2$, a 6% increase
- The total number of confirmation is 3,335 (3,029), an increase of 10%
- The research/1 year programmes ratio is 1:2
- For applications by Fee Status³: Overseas: 8,460 (62%) Home: 1,693 (12%) EU: 3,387 (25%) Undeclared: 185 (1%)
- For confirmations by Fee Status: Overseas: 1,433 (43%) Home: 1,051 (32%) EU: 851 (26%)

Table 1.2 Applications and Confirmations by HESA classification Research and Taught

- Research: 8,078 applications, 28% were confirmed.
- Taught: 5,647 applications, 20% were confirmed.

Table 1.3Applications and Confirmations by Citizenship

- The largest number of applications come from UK citizens, followed by Chinese and American citizens
- The top 25 citizenships made up 85% of total confirmations and UK citizens alone made up 31%.

Table 2.1-2.3 Applicants by Gender, Disability and Ethnicity

- Male applicants submitted 23% more applications than female.
 - On average the success rate for male applicants to be confirmed onto an academic programme is 1% higher than female applicants.
 - 453 (3.3%) of applicants declared one or more disability and 181 (40%) of these applicants were confirmed.
 - 48% of applicants declared non-white ethnicity.

Table 1.4 lists the Top 25 countries with citizens being confirmed. This table is different from previous Table 1.3 in terms of ranking by total number of confirmations received by citizenships. It also includes citizens from Austria, Belgium, Chile, Cyprus, Mexico, Netherlands, New Zealand and Spain previously excluded due to their total applications fewer than the Top 25 Countries in Table 1.3.

Netherlands and New Zealand have higher success rates of 46% and 45% respectively than United Kingdom.
