PhD Annual Increases

Home/EU students should allow for an annual inflationary increase of up to 5% each year for the 2nd and 3rd years. The fee presented here is for the **1st year only**.

Overseas PhD fees will be fixed at the level of the 2014/15 rate.
Notes on the figures above:

1. **Maintenance levels** are the basic 'minimum' amounts required to meet the financial condition of admission. Please note that overseas students are also recommended to make an extra provision of £350 to cover costs of settling in when moving to the UK from overseas.
2. **Ed.D (Doctor of Education)** - This course is only offered part-time over 5 years. Therefore, costs supplied in the above table are the actual part-time costs, not full-time costs. Applicants are not requested to provide a financial guarantee for maintenance costs, but should make provision for travel and accommodation expenses.
3. **M.A.St students** are treated as undergraduates for fee purposes, and are therefore charged the undergraduate College fee. The college fee provided is the maximum college fee charged in 12/13, please consult the college for exact college fee charges. M.A.St students from the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man will be charged a University Composition Fee of approximately £10,428 for continuing students who started a relevant course before **1 September 2012** and £10,500 for students who start a relevant course on or after **1 September 2012**. Except for Mathematics M.A.St students who will be charged approximately £8,211 for continuing students who started a relevant course before **1 September 2012** and £9,000 for students who start a relevant course on or after **1 September 2012**. The higher undergraduate fee (£9,000 in 2012/13) will be charged with effect from 2015/16. Students may be registered as ELQ for this course but there is no impact on the University fee payable.
4. **MPhil in Architecture & Urban Design**
 - a) University Composition Fee – as a 'continuing' undergraduate course, capped fees apply to Home/EU students. For 2014 entry, these fees are £3,465 per annum, or £1,380 if you started your undergraduate degree in Architecture before 1 September 2006.
 - b) College Fee – Private rate: the fee quoted in your offer letter is the maximum College fee payable by Overseas/Islands/ELQ Home/EU students.
 - c) College Fee – Public rate: If you are from the UK/EU and have completed an Undergraduate Architecture course in the UK within a relevant time frame, (e.g. less than 3 years gap) you may be eligible for 'public support' (e.g. from the Student Loan Company) and may not have to pay a College fee. UK/EU students who have been resident in the UK for the three years prior to the start of the course and have completed their Undergraduate Architecture course in the UK are likely to be eligible, but you must check your eligibility with your College. Contact your College Tutorial Office (once college membership has been obtained) in the first instance, or complete an assessment form from the Student Loans Company. Your College will be asked to report the outcome of your application to SLC to student.fees@admin.cam.ac.uk before the end of the September immediately before your course begins so that we can ensure the correct College fee is charged.
 - d) Student Loans Company – this is a registered course. This means that 'eligible students' (see guidance on eligible for public funding above) may apply to the Student Loans Company for support of your studies.
 - e) In the second year of this course, the University Composition Fee and College fee will be charged at a rate of 50% of that stated in your offer of admission.
5. **MPhil in Developmental Biology** This course can only be taken as part of the Integrated doctoral programme (IDP) in Developmental Biology
6. **MPhil in Medical Sciences & MPhil in Veterinary Science.** These courses may be 1 year or 2 years in length.
7. From 2013/14 **Islands** fee status students are charged at the Overseas rate.
8. **MD:** There is a one-off upfront university composition fee and college fee (payable in the first term).
9. **Diploma Theology & Religious Studies** For overseas and home/EU students, who are not publicly funded, there is a college fee of up to £6,663 (approx).
10. **MPhil in Biological Science** Maintenance rates provided are for 12 months. Course lengths vary and this figure will need to be adjusted accordingly.
