Getting around Cambridge

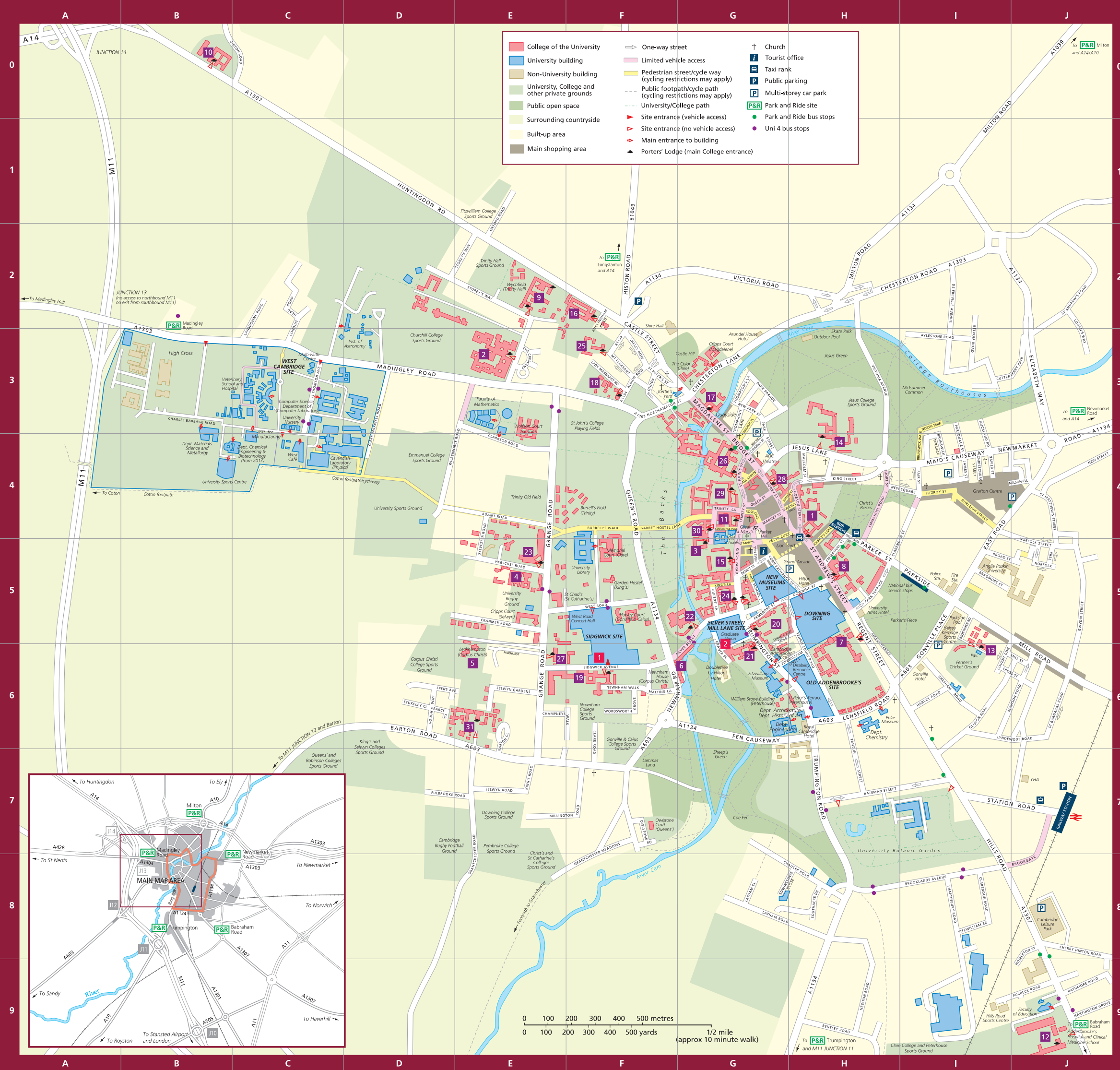
The University's faculties/departments and the Colleges are situated across Cambridge, though most are within walking distance of the city centre.

As Cambridge is fairly compact and better suited to pedestrians and cyclists than vehicles, wherever practical and possible we recommend getting around the city on foot or by bike – these are often the quickest means of transport and are also best for getting a sense of the city.

The Universal bus service runs between Madingley Road P&R site and Addenbrooke's Hospital. (Monday to Friday), linking some departments and Colleges with the city centre. 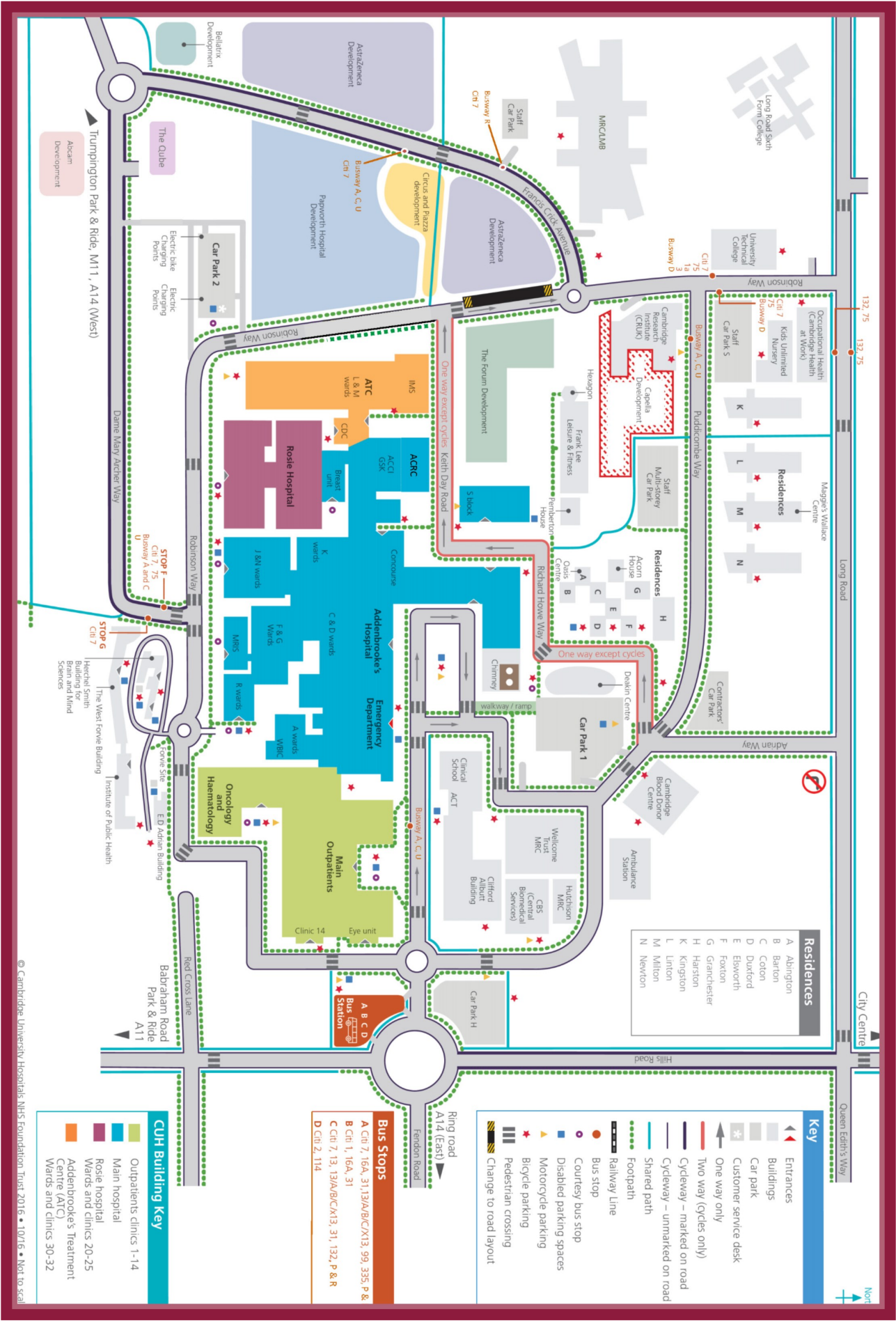
