- 2. The 2018-19 application cycle includes admission to Michaelmas Term 2018, Lent Term 2019 and Easter Term 2019. The cycle closed on 21 May 2019. Further information on the University's term dates can be found here: https://www.cam.ac.uk/about-the-university/term-dates-and-calendars
- 3. Confirmation figures show those applicants who satisfied all of their conditions set out in the offer stage, and who then subsequently registered and took up their places on the course. Applicants who were confirmed but subsequently did not take up their University place are excluded.1
- 4. Home/EU/Overseas fee status is defined only at the point of offer as this classification is dependent on a variety of factors that require independent assessment based on the <u>UKCISA guidelines</u>. For the purpose of estimating numbers of applicants within fee status categories who did not receive an offer, the fee status has been assessed based on primary citizenship only. Applicants with islands or refugee fee status have been included for this broad reporting purpose as Overseas.

Summary

The data has been prepared by Graduate Admissions Office for the Board of Graduate Studies (BGS) and Post-Graduate Admissions Committee (PAC) and are intended to provide a statistical analysis of applications, offers and confirmations³

Applications, offers and confirmations by School and Fee Status Table 1.1

- The total number of applications is $22,867 (21,776)^4$, a 5.0% increase.
- The total number of conditional offers is 7,060 (6,844), a 3.2% increase.
- The total number of confirmation is 3,919 (3,801), a 3.1% increase.
- The research programmes to taught programmes application ratio approximately 5:6

 - o **Applications:** Overseas: 14,071 (61.5%), Home: 4,899 (21.4%), EU: 3,897 (17.0%)

- The largest number of applications came from UK citizens (by primary citizenship only), followed by American and Chinese citizens
- The top 25 citizenships made up 84.6% of total applications
- UK citizens⁶ alone made up 22.5% of total applications.

Table 1.7 Applications, offers and confirmations for continuing students

- 1,227 applicants applied to continue their graduate studies. This is 19.4% more than the previous year.
- 59.3% received conditional offers and 53.9% of those were confirmed.

- 46.5% of applications were from females up 0.7% on the previous year
- 46.8% of total offers were to females up 1.6% on the previous year
- 47.2% of total confirmations were female up 0.8% on the previous year
- 7.1% of applicants declared a disability.
- 54.9% of applicants declared non-white ethnicity.
- 23.7% of UK citizen applicants⁶ declared non-white ethnicity.
