- 6. Application figures are for all postgraduate applications submitted to the 2020-21 application cycle, excluding applications to programmes admitted by the Postgraduate Admissions Office that were withdrawn within the terms of the 14 day cancellation policy.
- 7. Confirmation figures show those applicants who satisfied all of their conditions set out in the offer stage, and who then subsequently registered and took up their places on the course. Applicants who were confirmed but subsequently did not take up their University place are excluded.
- 8. Home/EU/Overseas fee status is defined only at the point of offer as this classification is dependent on a variety of factors that require independent assessment based on the <u>UKCISA guidelines</u>. For the purpose of estimating numbers of applicants within fee status categories who did not receive an offer, the fee status has been assessed based on primary citizenship only. Applicants with islands or refugee fee status have been included for this broad reporting purpose as Overseas.

### Introduction

The data has been prepared by the Postgraduate Admissions Office for the Postgraduate Admissions Committee (PAC) to provide a statistical analysis of Postgraduate applications, offers and confirmations for entry in the academic year 2020/2021

#### Total Applications, Offers and Confirmations – Table 1.1, Table 1.2

27,848 postgraduate applications were received:

- 8,241(29.6%) Doctoral, 19,607 (70.4%) Non-Doctoral
- 10,403 (37.4%) Research, 17,445 (62.6%) Taught
- 9,482 offers were made:
  - 2,586 Doctoral (27.3%), 6,896 (72.7%) Non-Doctoral
  - 3,347 (35.3%) Research, 6,135 (64.7%) Taught
- 5,315 students were admitted:
  - 1,467 (27.6%) Doctoral, 3,848 (72.4%) Non-Doctoral
  - 2,066 (38.9%) Research, 3,249 (61.1%) Taught

There was an increase of 9.5% in the total applications received (4.4% increase in doctoral applications and 11.7% increase in non-doctoral applications) in 2020-2021 cycle compared to the 2019-2020 cycle. Total conditional offers made increased by 10.7% (doctoral up by 3.5% and non-doctoral by 13.7%) and total admissions increased by 4.1% (doctoral by 7% and non-doctoral by 3.1%) – see <u>Appendix 2</u>

#### Fee status

The breakdown by fee status <sup>3</sup> is approximately:

- Applications: Overseas: 16,887 (62.4% of total applications), Home: 6,266 (23.2%), EU: 3,897 (14.4%)
- Offers: Overseas: 4,319 (51.7% of total offers), Home: 2,671 (32%), EU: 1,365 (16.3%)
- Confirmations: Overseas: 2,216 (43.6% of total confirmations), Home: 1,986 (39%), EU: 884 (17.4%) (see Table 1.3)

#### <u>Citizenship</u>

Almost one quarter of applicants are UK nationals, with Chinese and Unites States of America nationals forming the next largest applicant pool. The 10 most common nationalities of applicants make up 69.1% of the total applications received (see <u>Table 1.4-1.6</u>)<sup>4</sup>

### Part-Time

1,903 applicants applied for part-time programmes in 2020-2021, of which (see Table 1.7b)

- 69.7% were for programmes admitted by the Institute of Continuing Education,
- $\circ$  ~ 19.1% were for programmes admitted by the Postgraduate Admissions Office, and
- $\circ$   $\,$  11.2% for programmes admitted by the Judge Business School.

6.8% (1,903) of all applications were applications for a part-time programme; 11.2% (1,066) of all offers were for a part-time program; and 17.2% (914) of all students admitted were admitted to a part-time programme.

### **Continuer Students**

- Of the total applications (27,848), 1306 (4.6%) applications were from students continuing from postgraduate study at Cambridge
- Of the total offers (9,482), 754 (8%) offers were to students continuing from postgraduate study at Cambridge
- Of the total admissions (5,315), 453 (8.5%) were students continuing their postgraduate study at Cambridge

In comparison to 2019-2020, the total number of students choosing to continue their postgraduate studies at Cambridge had risen by 4.7% in 2020-2021.

#### <u>Gender</u>

- From the total number of applications (27,848), 47.6% of applicants were Female and 52.1% Male and 0.3% (87) applicants have reported their Gender as 'Other' or 'Unknown'. (See <u>Table 1.9</u>)
- From the total number of offers (8,595)<sup>5</sup>, 49.3% of offer holders were Female, 50.4% Male and 0.3% were 'Other' or 'Unknown'.
- From the total number of admissions (4,928)<sup>5</sup>, 50.7% of confirmed students were Female, 48.9%
   Male and 0.4% were 'Other' or 'Unknown'.

#### **Disability**

- o Of the total number of applications (27,848), 9.1% of applicants declared disability
- o Of the total number of Offers (8595)<sup>6</sup>, 12% offer holders declared disability

• Of the total number of Confirmations (4928)<sup>6</sup>, 13.4% of confirmed students declared disability. (See <u>Table 1.10a</u>)<sup>6</sup>.

In comparison to 2019-2020, there was an increase of 149 applicants on those who were admitted in 2020-21 who had declared disability, a 29.2% increase. See <u>Table 1.10b</u><sup>6</sup>

#### **Ethnicity**

- From the total number of applications (27,848), 61.1% applicants declared a non-white ethnicity
- From the total number of Offers (8595)<sup>7</sup>, 46.1% offer holders declared a non-white ethnicity
- From the total number of Confirmations (4928)<sup>7</sup>, 42.3% confirmed students declared a non-white ethnicity. see <u>Table 2.1a</u>

When looking at the UK nationals<sup>8</sup> only, 33.1% applicants, 26.1% of offer holders, and 25.4% of UK confirmed students had declared a non-white ethnicity (see <u>Table 2.1b</u>)




