## **Application Fee Waiver Form**

We particularly welcome applications from women, internally displaced people, and people with disabilities for these scholarships. The University actively supports equality, diversity and inclusion and encourages applications from all sections of society.

Please complete all fields in order to request a waiver of the £50 application fee for admission in the academic year 2023/24. A decision will be sent to you directly via email within **ten working days**.

## Please note:

- To be eligible for an application fee waiver you must have started an application to study via the <u>Postgraduate Applicant Portal</u>, but not submitted it
- You must have completed and submitted the <u>Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program application</u> form
- You should use the same email address for this form that you used to register on the Applicant Portal
- We will usually only offer a waiver for applications which you have started (but not submitted) on the Applicant Portal at the time we consider your request. However, waivers can be considered retrospectively for those who had already submitted their application to study and subsequently submit an eligible application for the Mastercard Foundation Scholarship

## **Deadlines:**

- For applicants with a 1 December 2022 funding deadline, you need to submit your fee waiver form at least five working days before the course deadline ( at the latest by 25 November 2022);
- For applicants with a 5 January 2023 funding deadline, you need to submit your fee waiver form at the latest by 19 December 2022;
- For applicants applying for a reimbursement of their application fee, you need to have completed this form and the <u>Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program application form</u> at the latest by 5 January 2023.
